The Wilds S2 Conversation:

- Despite negative <u>conversation</u> around <u>sensitive</u> themes in the season, fan <u>sentiment</u> of season 2 has <u>mostly</u> veered in an <u>overall receptive direction</u>. A myriad of fans <u>binged</u> the season in <u>less</u> than 24 hours and requests for <u>another</u> season <u>continuously pour</u> in.
- Some fans expressed that there was too much of a focal point on the boys without
 developing a connection to them previously; while the girls' storylines felt rushed and
 dismissed. Various fans confessed to skipping scenes with the boys.
- The scenes involving delicate subjects such as <u>sexual assault</u> and <u>suicide</u> left some fans <u>aggravated</u> at the <u>depictions</u>, highlighting the potentially damaging <u>impacts</u> towards the <u>queer community</u>. A heavily circulated time stamped <u>trigger warning thread</u> was shared between the fandom online who may be particularly distressed by certain scenes.
- While viewers <u>continue</u> to maintain "<u>Shoni</u>" as the fan <u>favorite</u> pairing; Leah and Fatin
 (AKA "<u>Leatin</u>") have been rapidly <u>emerging</u> as a season <u>spotlight</u>. Shoni admirers have
 <u>conveyed heartbreak</u> over the couple's <u>breakup</u>, while being <u>hopeful</u> for what may come
 of <u>Leatin</u>.
- The <u>performances</u> of the <u>girls</u> were <u>widely celebrated</u>, with an <u>abundance</u> of fans highlighting <u>Reign Edwards</u> and <u>Sarah Pidgeon</u> specifically.

Key Takeaways

- Throughout the year, there was strong momentum for S2 aided by consistent posting, which created fan excitement. On the IG grid, the top performing post (11.97% ER) was a carousel with the cast showing the number 2, a play on the date (2/22/22) and teasing season 2. The next top performing post was a carousel featuring Shoni (10.51% ER) posted on the release date.
- Most Reels generated higher than the YTD Median views and engagements. The top
 performing Reel featured fan-favorite couple, Shoni, for <u>Lesbian Visibility Day</u>. This was
 an effective tie-in to culturally relevant conversations through Original characters.
- On Twitter, the top performing 4 posts were all from the launch weekend with each showing images or albums with favorite characters.
